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## EPRO (EMERGENCY PATIENT RESOURCES & OPTIONS) POST - STABILIZATION POLICY

Dear Provider,

Starting **January 1, 2020**, Kaiser Permanente of Washington will require notification at the time of stabilization and prior to hospital admission. Providers can contact Kaiser Permanente through the EPRO 24/7 access line at 1-800-337-3197. This is in accordance to Washington State Legislature <u>RCW</u> <u>48.43.093</u>.

This payment policy states that "failure to contact Emergency Patient Resources & Options (EPRO) in the post-stabilization setting prior to admission will result in non-coverage of the hospital stay."

Additional key points of the policy state:

1. Notification at the time of stabilization, prior to a hospital admission is required:

For the following admission types\*

- I. Inpatient
- II. Observation
- III. Ambulatory status

\* If prior authorization has already been obtained for the admission through the review services process (typically elective admissions), EPRO notification is not needed.

- a. For transfers from either the emergency room or inpatient hospital.
- b. It is the responsibility of the accepting hospital to make sure that EPRO has been contacted for the stay. This call may also be initiated by the sending hospital.
- c. No notification is required to EPRO if the patient is treated in the emergency room and is not planning to be admitted. However, EPRO can assist with coordination on follow-up care if this is requested.
- d. No notification is required for emergent behavioral health admission. Non-emergent admissions to other levels of care as in residential treatment center (RTC), partial hospitalization program (PHP) and intensive outpatient program (IOP), require preauthorization. This can be obtained by calling Mental Health Access Center at 206-630-1680 or toll-free at 888-287-2680, Monday Friday from 8 am to 5 pm, or EPRO after hours. EPRO can provide authorization for inpatient detoxification if indicated.
