

MODIFIERS JA AND JB

Scope This policy applies to: ☑ Kaiser Permanente Health Plan of Health Plan of Washington Options, Inc. ☑ Commercial ☑ Medicare □ Medicaid Original Effective Date: 07/15/2021

When benefits allow, Kaiser Permanente will reimburse for medications that have one J Code for multiple routes of administration. To allow for proper monitoring of dose and treatment frequency, the JA or JB modifier must be present on the claim to indicate the route of administration as either intravenous or subcutaneous. Claims for drugs that fall under this category will be reviewed and the lack of a JA or JB modifier may result in a claim denial.
